

1. Short verses from the Psalms

Psalms 147:3; Psalm 31:3; 31:14-15; 6:6-7, 9; 107:13-14; 73:26; 34:17; 16:8; 41:2-3; 23:4; 94:19; 91:1-2.

Ps 147:3 He heals the brokenhearted,
and binds up their wounds.

Ps 31:3 You are indeed my rock and my fortress;
for your name's sake lead me and guide me,

Ps 31:14 But I trust in you, O LORD;
I say, "You are my God."

15 My times are in your hand;
deliver me from the hand of my enemies and persecutors.

Ps 6:6 I am weary with my moaning;
every night I flood my bed with tears;
I drench my couch with my weeping.
7 My eyes waste away because of grief;
they grow weak because of all my foes.

Ps 6:9 The LORD has heard my supplication;
the LORD accepts my prayer.

Ps 107:13 Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble,
and he saved them from their distress;
14 he brought them out of darkness and gloom,
and broke their bonds asunder.

Ps 73:26 My flesh and my heart may fail,
but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

Ps 34:17 When the righteous cry for help, the LORD hears,
and rescues them from all their troubles.

Ps 16:8 I keep the LORD always before me;
because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved.

Ps 41:2 The LORD protects them and keeps them alive;
they are called happy in the land.
You do not give them up to the will of their enemies.

3 The LORD sustains them on their sickbed;
in their illness you heal all their infirmities.

- Ps 23:4 Even though I walk through the darkest valley,
I fear no evil;
for you are with me;
your rod and your staff—
they comfort me.
- Ps 94:19 When the cares of my heart are many,
your consolations cheer my soul.
- Ps 91:9 Because you have made the LORD your refuge,
the Most High your dwelling place,
10 no evil shall befall you,
no scourge come near your tent.
- Ps 49:15 But God will ransom my soul from the power of Sheol,
for he will receive me.
